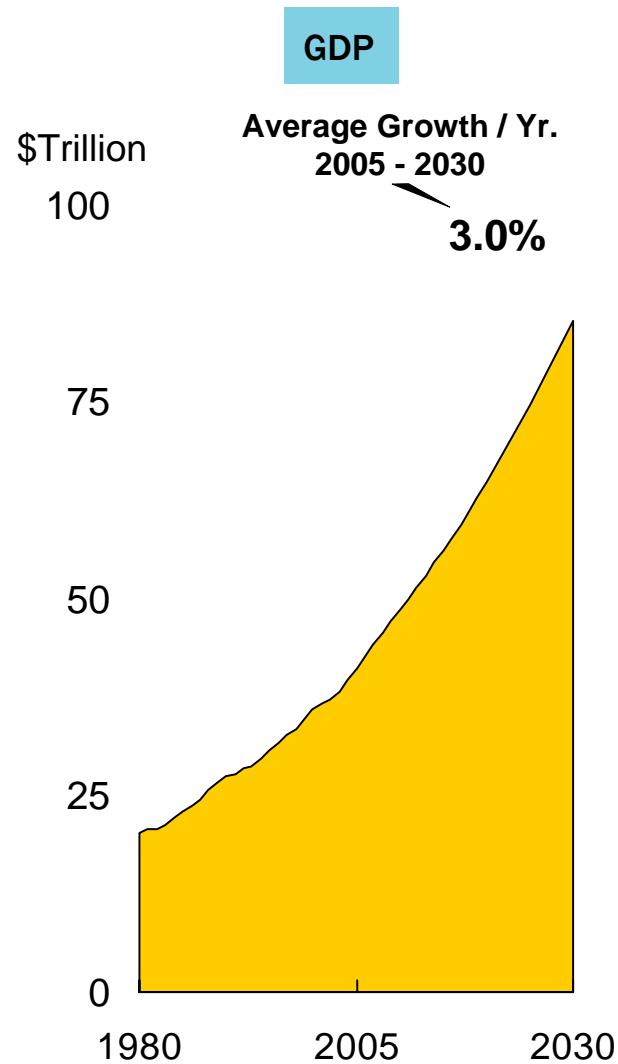

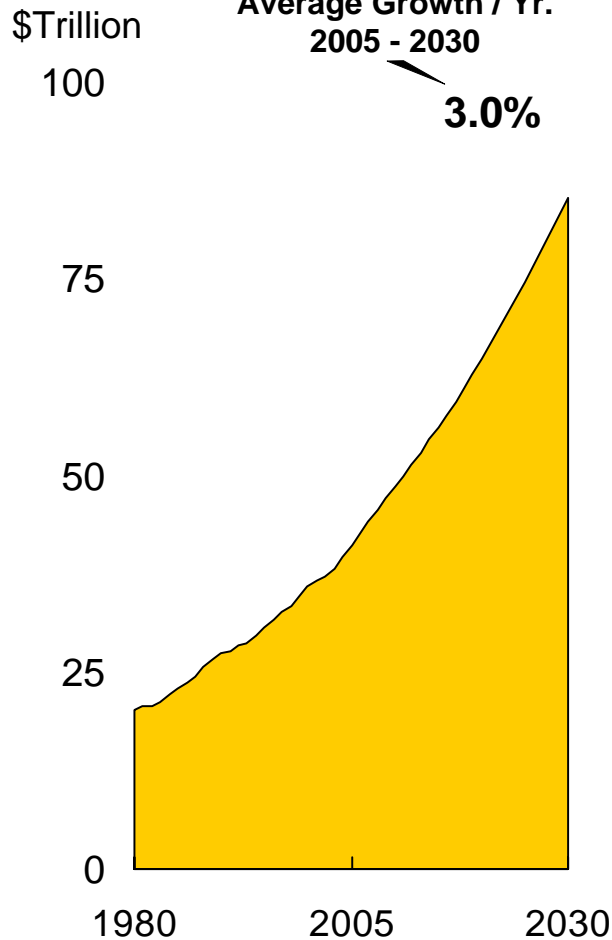


Global Economics and Energy

2005 - 2030

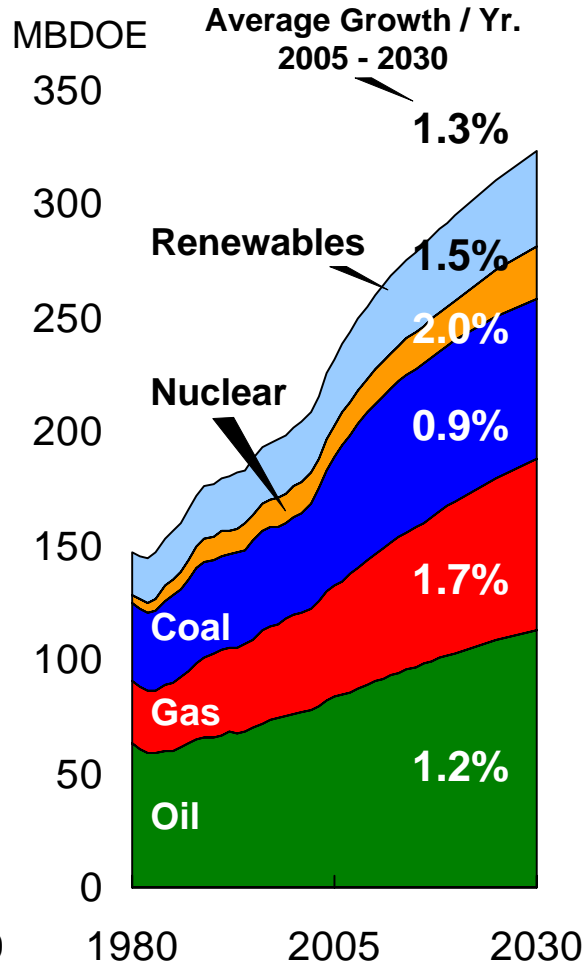
