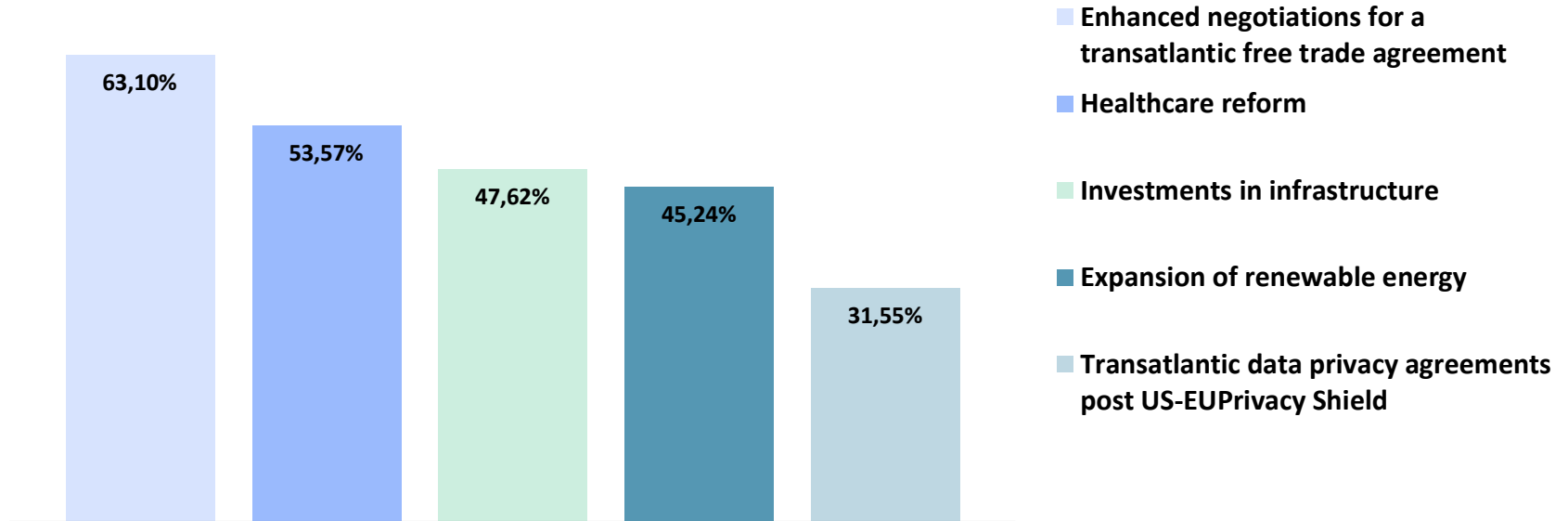
Survey on the US before the Presidential Election 2020

- Survey period: September 7-11, 2020

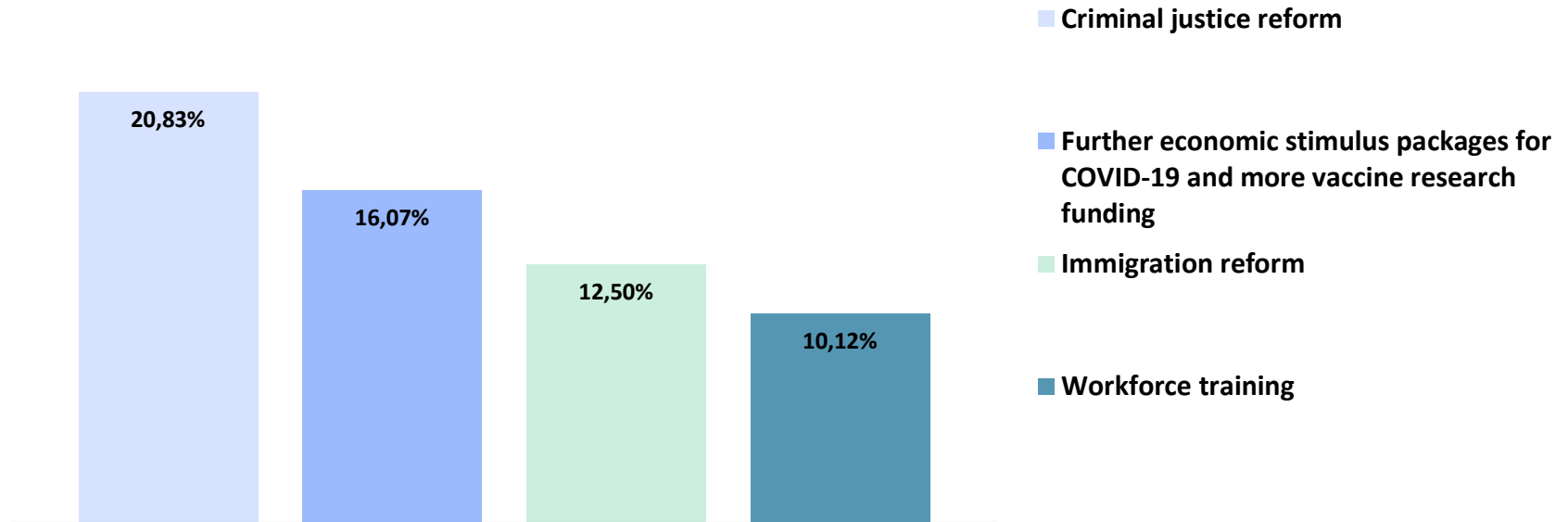

1. Regardless of the electoral results, what policy issues should the next US Administration pursue the most?



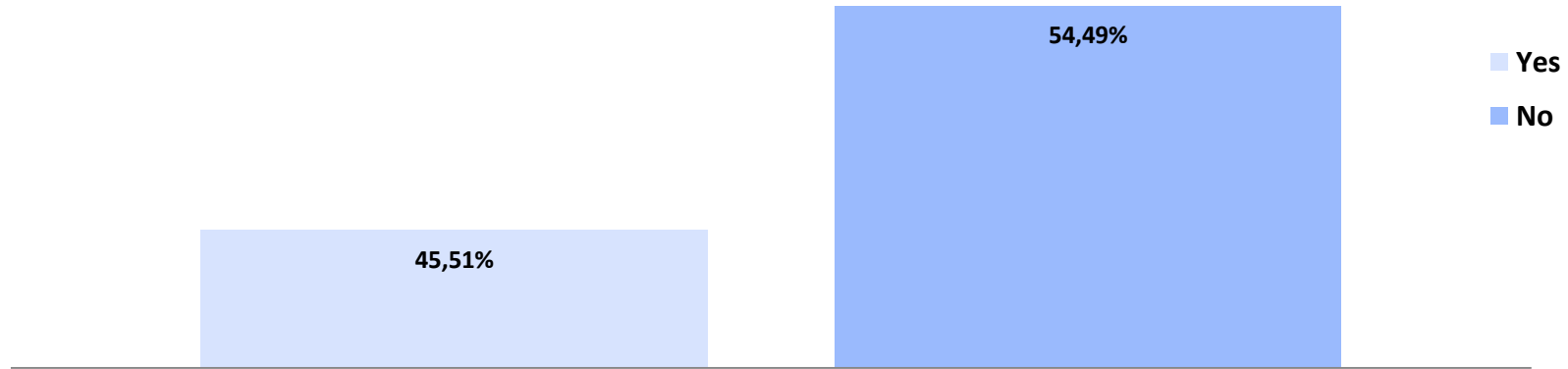

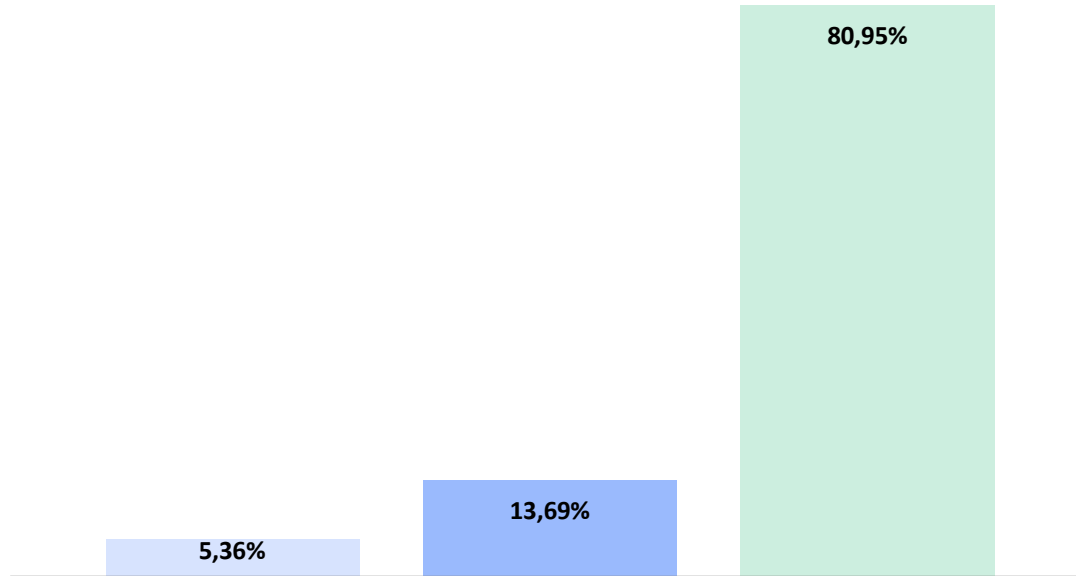
2. Do you believe that the US Congress will be capable of passing key political legislation over the next four years – regardless of its political composition after the election?



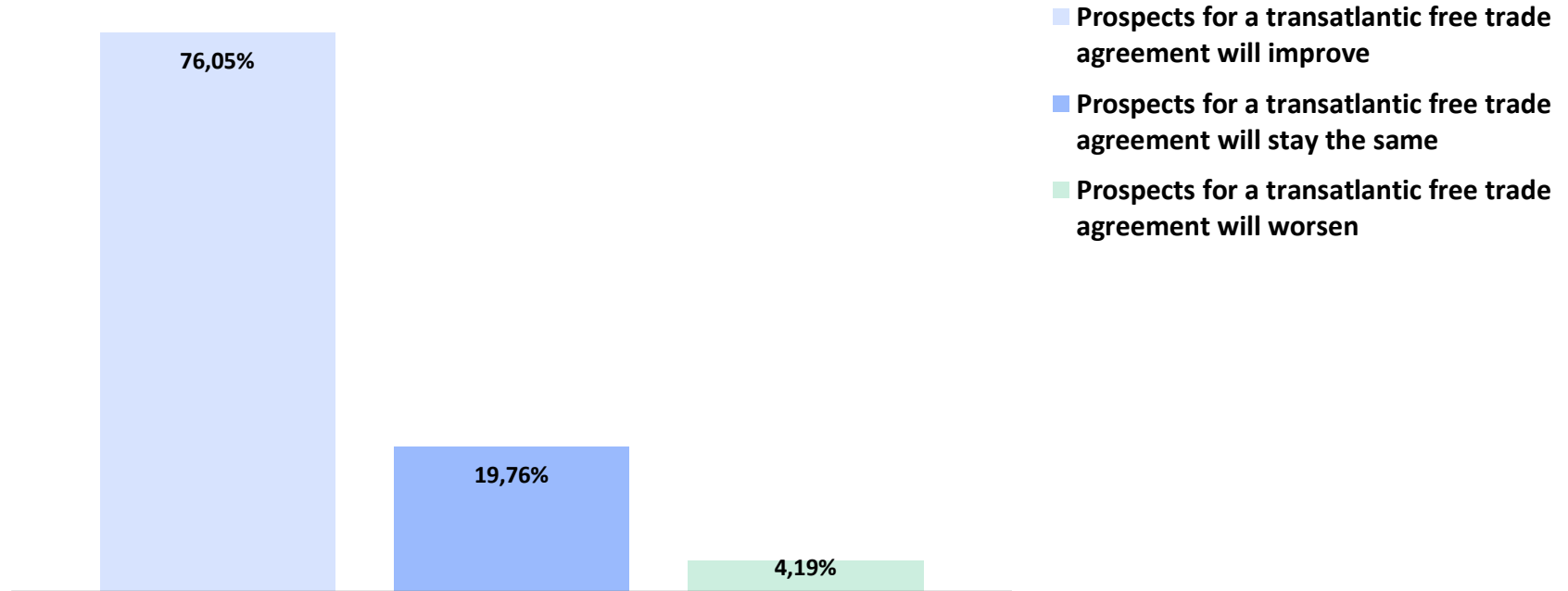

- Prospects for a transatlantic free trade agreement will worsen

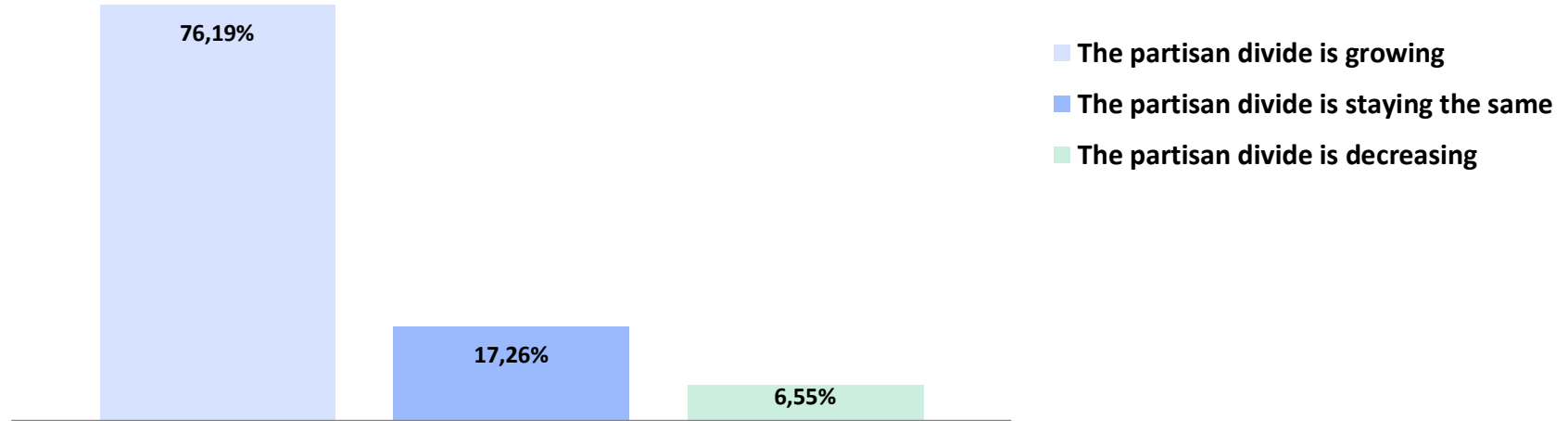


4. In the event that Joe Biden wins the election, how do you feel this will impact prospects for a transatlantic free trade agreement?

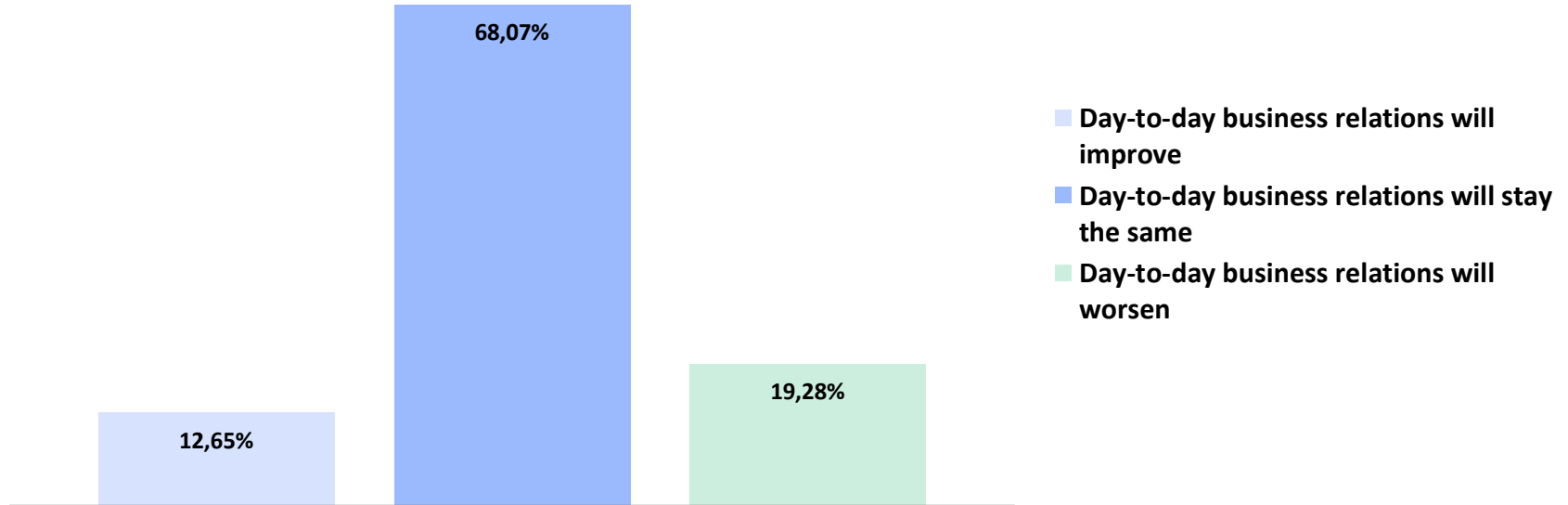
